WHAT IS A REHABILITATION ASSISTANT?

The **Rehabilitation Assistant** is responsible for providing care, support, comfort and safety to clients in a Rainbow residential home, residential facility or their own individual residence.

Duties include:

- assisting with activities of daily living such as personal hygiene, showering, dressing, toileting, etc.
- administering bedside care and performing health care related tasks such as monitoring vital signs and medication under the direction of the nursing staff
- performing housekeeping duties such as cooking, cleaning, laundry, dishes, running errands, personal shopping, planning and preparing meals
- using a company vehicle to transport clients to and from locations outside the home such as appointments and outings

Through their interactions and activities with adult and pediatric clients, the **Rehabilitation Assistant** plays an important role in the rehabilitation of our clients, assisting Rainbow professional staff in administering therapeutic rehabilitation programs in the home and at the treatment center. Therapeutic rehabilitation programs may include:

- ambulation
- swimming
- physical exercises
- leisure activities
- arts and crafts
- recreational games
- community outings
